
This dual enrollment option is available to eligible students ~~after~~ ^{at} their first or second semester in the Harford Community College (HCC) Nursing Program. Admission is competitive and based on completed courses, grade point average (GPA), and professional conduct during year one in the HCC Nursing Program. HCC's LPN to RN Transition students are eligible to apply to ATB 2.0 contingent upon successful completion of the transition course.

The HCC and TU Nursing Department will review completed applications for acceptance into the ATB option. Students will be notified by either email and/or letter with their admission decision. Any offer of admission given will be contingent upon successful completion of currently enrolled nursing courses at HCC. Students will be required to submit an updated transcript after the completion of the spring term to verify their nursing grades.

Students will be charged tuition and fees based on the policies of each institution. Tuition and fees are subject to change each academic year. If students are using financial aid, it will be processed through the TU Financial Aid Office based on the total enrollment at both institutions. For the purposes of tuition and financial aid, students must be aware that the ATB option involves part
