Applicants: B.S. Music Education Sophomores / Juniors

All music education students are considered candidates for the B.S. in Music Education degree for Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) teacher licensing (certifying students to teach music at the PreK-12 level in Maryland Public Schools and other states with reciprocal agreements) until they apply to and are admitted into the Music Education degree program, and must meet the following Music Education requirements for acceptance into the Program.

Requirements:

GPA

*Earned 3.0 cumulative GPA for all post-secondary institutions attended. Earned 3.0 GPA in Music Education major courses.

*If you **do not** have a GPA of 3.0 at the time of application and you would like to be considered for conditional admission (and your GPA is between a 2.5-2.99), then you will need to provide evidence of passing one of the basic skills requirements below at the time of application.
